I can stand on the feet while I wait.



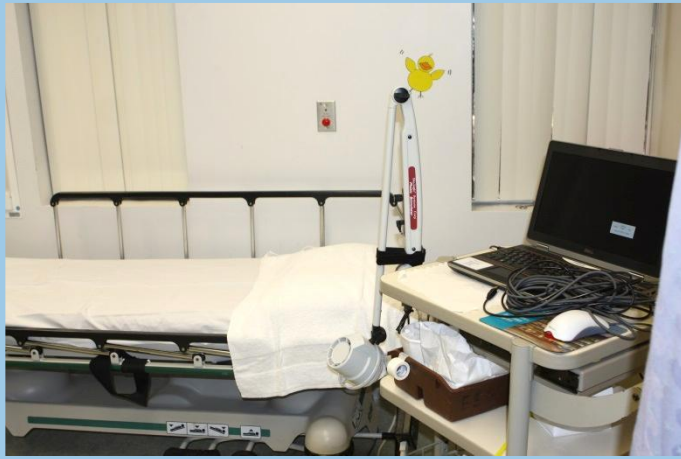
I can look at the fish tank while I wait.

The nurse will let me play with a pinwheel before we start!



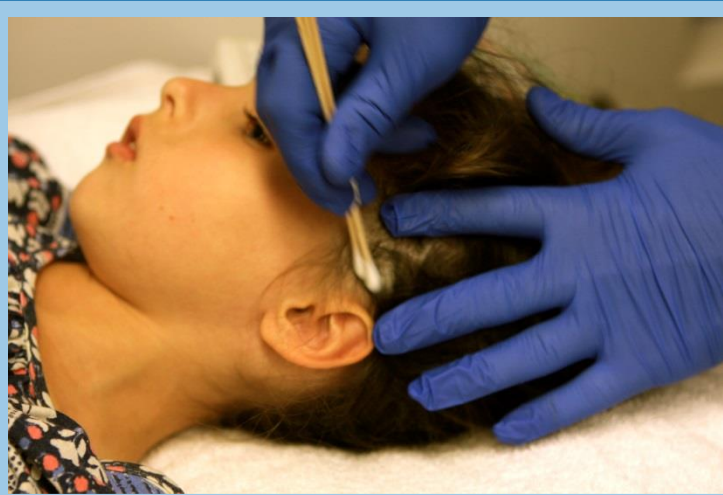
We can pretend the wires are scoops to dip in a bowl of ice cream!

The nurse will put the ice cream scoops on my head while I look at my toy.



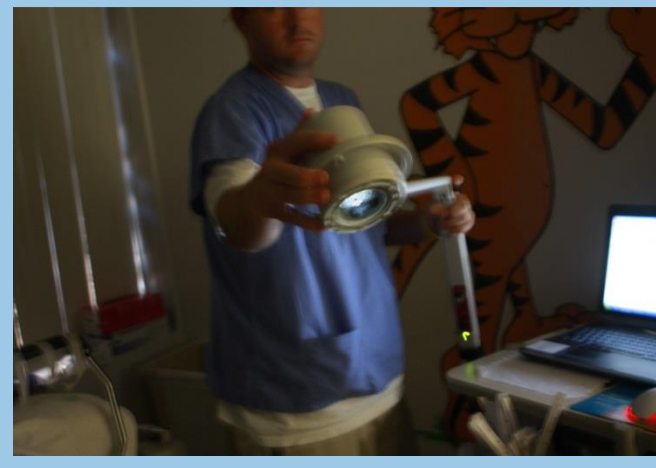
It tickles and makes kids smile when they get ice cream scoops on their head!
