

# Rady Children's Hospital Distribution Planning

## A PHASED APPROACH TO VACCINE ALLOCATION FOR COVID-19

### PHASE 1A\*

- **HEALTH CARE PERSONNEL (HCP)** = all Rady Children's staff and physicians
- Long-Term Care Facility **RESIDENTS**

Distribution\* within **PHASE I** is by risk defined by the CDC:

- **Highest** – Direct patient care with high-risk exposures (AGP)
- **High** – Direct or indirect patient care with less exposure
- **Moderate** – Support Patient care
- **Low** – Rare interaction with any patient

### PHASE 1B\*\*

- **ESSENTIAL WORKERS** (e.g., Education sector, food & agriculture, utilities, police, firefighters, corrections officers, transportation)

### PHASE 1C\*\*

- Adults with high-risk **MEDICAL CONDITIONS**
- Adults 65+

\*Our staff/physicians who meet this high risk medical and condition and age criteria will be vaccinated in Phase I

### PHASE 2

- **CHILDREN and YOUNG ADULTS** 30 and younger
- Critical workers not in Phase 1 or 2

### PHASE 3

- **EVERYONE** else living in the U.S.

*\*Once prepared, the batch of vaccine has to be used within a short time frame. In order to avoid waste, a notification may periodically go out to other groups to avoid wasting prepared doses.*
