Dr. Tyler Morrison is a second-year Child and Adolescent Psychiatry Fellow at the University of California, San Diego. After teaching high school students and studying Japanese for years in central Japan, Dr. Morrison completed his MD, as well as a master's degree in clinical research, at the University of California, San Diego. He trained in adult psychiatry at UC San Francisco, where he was accepted into the Residency Research Training Program. He used his protected residency research time to conduct one arm of a randomized controlled trial of the effects of intranasal oxytocin in participants with co-occurring PTSD and Alcohol Use Disorder. He also trained at the San Francisco Center for Psychoanalysis and enjoys providing psychotherapy for his patients. He is currently focused on quality improvement and health systems research, with additional interests in implementation science and psychotherapy research.
