#### **Risk Categories Eligible for Treatment**

- · Age 65 or older
- Are obese or overweight, with a body mass index (BMI) of 25 or greater
- Pregnancy
- Have diabetes, chronic kidney disease, or a condition that weakens the immune system
- Have heart disease, high blood pressure, or lung disease (like asthma)
- Other medical conditions or factors (for example, race or ethnicity) that may place the patient at high risk for progression to severe COVID-19

In a high risk

#### **Eligible for Post-Exposure Prophylaxis**

- Not fully vaccinated or not expected to mount an adequate immune response to complete SARS CoV-2 vaccination AND:
- Close contact with an individual infected with SARS-CoV-2, or
- At high risk of exposure to an individual infected with SARS-CoV-2 infection in other individual in the same institutional setting (for example, nursing homes, prisons).
