Aradhana Bela Sood, MD is Professor of Psychiatry and Pediatrics, was Chair of Child and Adolescent Psychiatry and Training Director of the Child Psychiatry Fellowship program at VCUHS. She was the Medical Director of VTCC at Virginia Commonwealth University, Richmond, VA till 2014 and has transitioned into the role of senior professor for child mental health policy. She completed her MD from India, her residency at the University of Missouri in Kansas City, and child psychiatry fellowship at Ohio State University and joined VCU in 1988. She is a 2002 Fellow of the Executive Leadership in Academic Medicine (ELAM) through Drexel University and completed a Masters of Science in Health Administration in May 2006 from the Health Administration Program at VCU. She has served on the SOM admissions committee, faculty awards committee, COSOWAM, special faculty awards committee, presidential task force on campus safety, and Psychiatry P&T committee. Her special interests are in the training of an adequate workforce in child mental health, reduction of stigma around mental health issues, outcomes research, Mood disorders, and ADHD.
