What

A study to look at whether giving an investigational therapeutic probiotic to infants may help prevent allergic diseases.

Who

Pregnant women and their healthy infants up to 14 days old may be eligible. One of the baby's biological parents or siblings must have a history of asthma, seasonal allergies, atopic dermatitis (eczema) or food allergy.
