What is the pre-operative tour?

- The pre-operative tour is a tour that is led by a pediatric nurse who will use child friendly language and medical equipment to help prepare your child for their upcoming procedure.
 - We recommend the tour be for children 3 years and older.

How many people can attend?

- Two caregivers and the patient are allowed to attend the tour.
- If siblings and/or any other family members are present, they may be asked to wait outside.
