#### **OBJECTIVES**

There has been shift in healthcare communication away from disease-focused interactions toward patient/experience-focused communication. This shift embraces the role of the patient and their family in the encounter to achieve more balanced/meaningful conversations. Unresolved challenges, such as denial of the hearing loss, lack of confidence managing hearing needs or inconsistent hearing aid use can contribute to unsuccessful outcomes. While audiologists are traditionally successful with the assessment/intervention of hearing loss, their lack of training in managing critical conversations can limit the success of the (re)habilitation. It has also been documented that 30-40% of all children with hearing loss have additional developmental disabilities and at least 30% have an associated genetic syndrome. Given the increased complexity of the cases that we manage, engaging in meaningful and often difficult conversations has become a formidable task.

Speakers will give a unique prospective on managing complex conversations, providing concrete tools for enhancing sensitivity when counseling families. They will provide planning and treatment strategies for providing care for the most challenging patients. In addition, relevant case histories will be presented. The impact we have on successful management of patients and their families will be explored throughout.
