

### IMPORTANT Safety Concern Regarding Abbott Formula

We are sharing a safety alert for our parents and caregivers.

The Food and Drug Administration is warning consumers not to use certain powdered formulas due to risk of contamination. The specific powdered formula **Nutramigen if the following information is on the container:**

- ZL3FHG (12.6 oz cans)
- ZL3FMH (12.6 oz cans)
- ZL3FPE (12.6 oz cans)
- ZL3FQD (12.6 oz cans)
- ZL3FRW (19.8 oz cans) and
- ZL3FXJ (12.6 oz cans)

The products have a UPC Code of 300871239418 or 300871239456 and "Use By Date" of "1 Jan 2025".

If your formula is included in the recall, **discontinue use immediately** and contact your healthcare provider or Rady Children's HomeCare for an alternative formula.

Look for code on bottom of packaging near the expiration date to see if your child's formula is included in the recall:
