

## OBJECTIVES

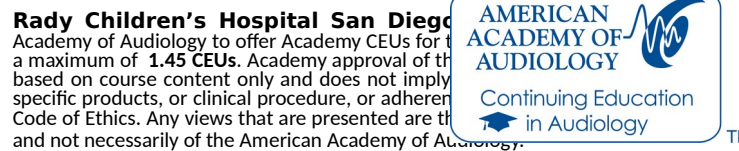
Meaningful connections with friends, co-workers and colleagues have been shown to reduce stress and anxiety as well as preserve mental well-being. Collaboration both within and across disciplines not only strengthens the care we provide to families but increases our resilience when confronted with stressful work situations. It has been shown that collaboration eliminates isolation, improves communication and transparency and problem solving. Connection also promotes higher levels of job and personal satisfaction.

We will examine and develop an appreciation of protective factors, particularly social connections and how, as professionals, we can foster avenues for families to take advantage of skills they already possess to become even stronger. We will explore avenues for cultivating professional relationships that support the lives of your families.

## CONTINUING EDUCATION



Upon completion of this program, participants will be able to identify the benefits of social connections; practice using tools to support themselves and others in creating social connections; describe how the protective factor of social connection can enhance a families' resilience and explain how they can apply newly learned principles to constructively contribute to a culture of connection across different disciplines with families.
